

CERTIFICATE IN MINISTERIAL TRAINING

Total Number of Units: 41 Units

The Certificate in Ministerial Training is a post-secondary program intended for persons who hold a high school diploma or equivalency certificate, but who have not completed a bachelor's degree. This program is designed to equip students for effective ministry as a pastor, associate pastor, church planter, missionary, or evangelist. It seeks to provide students with the general knowledge of the biblical, theological, and historical contexts of the Christian faith and to utilize insights gained therefrom for the effective practice of ministry in the church, the community, and the world.

This certificate program is terminal and non-transferable to any degree program.
